RESEARCH STATEMENT

My research and art making practice focuses on the complicated experiences my paternal grandparents and thousands of other Japanese Canadians endured throughout their forced incarceration during the Second World War and in the years after. Exploring the different forms and incarnations that memory can take, I investigate how specific memories can be navigated, remembered and revisited. In doing so, I am looking at various ways of story-telling, including historical and fictional narratives. Currently, my primary focus of research is on oral narratives and personal interviews. A secondary focus of my research is on the theory of postmemory, a term coined by Marianne Hirsch, that looks at how trauma continues to affect and form the foundation of cultural communities. Pulling inspiration from my research, my studio practice involves working with traditional and non-traditional printmaking processes, digital printing, drawing, papermaking and installation based approaches.
